Natural Variation

Customers should expect differences in color, shading, tone, movement, variation in veining, natural features such as dark lines, dull spots, and fissures. These are inherent characteristics of natural stone, not defects. Natural stone will not have a uniform or consistent appearance like quartz or other manufactured materials. If a consistent look is desired, a man-made product may be a better option.

Handling & Performance

Taj Mahal Quartzite performs well after installation. However, due to its natural composition, minor changes can occur during fabrication, transport, or installation. Fissures may become more visible and small areas of flaking or separation can occur. When this happens, repairs may be completed in accordance with industry standards established by the Natural Stone Institute.
